# New Year, New Adventures!

We're looking forward to a lot of exciting events ahead. Our first big concert will be the Songs of Faith concert at Kent Town Uniting Church on the 7<sup>th</sup> of April, but you can catch us before that on Sunday, the 17<sup>th</sup> of March at St Francis of Assisi Church at Christies Beach. Later this year in September we'll be on tour in Tasmania, performing in Launceston and Hobart.

## Songs of Faith

Our first big concert of the year is our Songs of Faith program. We will be performing this on the 7<sup>th</sup> of April at 2.00 pm at Kent Town Uniting Church.

The Choir will present favourite Songs of Faith including rousing choruses by Handel and Rutter as well as traditional Hymns such as **Calon Lan** and **Be Thou My Vision**, and beautiful reflective sacred works by Faure, Schubert, Bruckner and Randall Thompson. This concert features an orchestra as well as special supporting artists.



Organist (and former Deputy Music Director of the MMCSA) **Andrew Georg** (pictured left) will play solo works accompanied by the orchestra by Albinoni and Guilmant.

'Cellist **James Munro** will perform Kol Nidrei by Max Bruch. Mezzo Soprano **Naomi Hede** (right) will perform works by Mozart, Franck and Gounod.

The orchestra will perform Overture to the Oratorio St Paul, by Mendelssohn.

Tickets for the concert are just \$25 for Friends of the Choir if purchased during the month of February. They will go on sale to the public on trybooking.com at \$30 per ticket on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March. So
